& also securities all of the above named articles and notes being her own
individual property or the proceeds of her own estate is hereby bequeathed
to her and it is hereby understood that she is to receive also the property
usually set apart to the widow just the same as if no special bequest
had been made That is all the articles on hand usually set apart for widows
and One third of all the balance of my personal estate of which I may be
possessed at my demise. I do further make constitute and appoint my
