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I Jesse P. Lewis of the County of Breckinridge and State of Kentucky being of sound mind and disposing Memory ~~do hereby~~ and publish this my last will and Testament: hereby revoking all others heretofore made
1st I give devise and bequeath to Stationer Moorman, Sister of ^{my} deceased wife the Sum of Five Thousand Dollars, to be paid to her by my Executors in Henderson Bonds, which I now have on hands, Having heretofore conveyed to her Certain Lots in Cloverport on which I reside and, Constituted my home, I omitted in the deed Lot No 218 Conveyed to me on the 2nd day of October 1872 by Frank Frazer Commissioner and of record in Book 28 page 542 Breckinridge ^{County} Clerk's office, I hereby devise the said Lot to her, having intended to convey it to her when the said deed was made It, Commonly Known as the Hake Lot.

2nd I direct my Executors to deposit in the Breckinridge Bank at Cloverport Ky. the Sum of Five Thousand Dollars in Henderson Bonds and hereby constitute said Bank as Trustee for the purpose. The said Bank is to hold and keep and preserve the same and pay the Interest thereof as it accrues to my Father in law Jesse Moorman and his wife Rebecca, during the lives of either, ~~or both~~ of them. At their death I devise and direct said fund to be divided equally between my brothers and Sisters and their descendants

3rd The residue of my Estate of whatsoever description and of every kind of property whatever, that I may own or be entitled to at my death, I give, devise and bequeath to my brothers and Sisters or their descendants to be divided Equally between them viz to the Children of my brother now deceased John P. Lewis one part; to the Children of my deceased Sister Elizabeth Alger one part; to the Children of my deceased Sister Martha Queen one part; to David B. Lewis my brother one part; and to Thomas J. Lewis my brother one part; each part to be equal.

4th I hereby appoint my brothers David B. Lewis and Thomas J. Lewis my Executors and earnestly request them to Carry out the provisions of this Will
