I John McInnes do hereby make my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say 1st I desire that Stephen B Rubin to be appointed my executor first I desire that my said Executor to sell as much of my property I now own as the family can spare and if the proceeds of said property do not pay all my just d^{ts} I then desire my executor to sell my old place some fifteen acres more or less and apply the proceeds to paying my debts I hereby give said Executor full power to sell and convey said land I also desire that after my wife's death that all my estate be equally divided between my children except my daughter Eliza Jane McInnes now wife of William Vandegraes I desire that she is only to receive two dollars and fifty cents out of my estate as some of my oldest children has received some property after my wife's death I desire that the younger children first to receive in value up to what the older ones has received and then the balance of my estate be equally divided between all of my children except my daughter Eliza as above named my son Thomas McInnes has bought a horse of me at Eighty two dollars & fifty cents and has paid me twenty eight dollars on said horse I desire that he keep the horse by paying the balance of the value of said horse to the estate This is my last will and testament where I have hereunto set my hand and seal 7th Day of Oct 1857
