& personal as long as she lives & at her death I give all
of my land to Jane Richardson wife of my nephew Joseph
Richardson (Third) all of my negroes is to be sold to men
in Breckinridge County & are not to be taken out of the
County without the men who owns their wives should
move out of the County then the may be sold & go
with them (fourth) all of my other property is to be sold
& after my just debts are paid & a good stone wall
made Round my grave & my wifes & a Town Stone on both
graves The balance of my money is to be paid as follows
(fourth) \$150 to each of my negroes & \$200 to Sally My
youngest daughter that is deformed daughter of Levi
Latimore all of the balance of the money is to be given
as follows one half to Leanne Rumerson the other half to
Sally My & her children & all of the money to be payed
one year After my wifes death given under my hand
this 23 day of April 1851 & acknowledged in presence
of these witnesses
