The following is a correct statement of what I have given my children, intending to make them equal, to my son George Howell I have given the sum of two hundred and seventy five dollars, to Riley Howell the sum of two hundred dollars, to James Howell the sum of two hundred dollars, to John Howell the sum of two hundred dollars, to Alexander Howell the sum of two hundred dollars, to Polly Legrand the sum of two hundred dollars, to Ezra Howell the sum of two hundred dollars, to my daughter Jane Lipes, also two hundred dollars. My son in Law Charles Lipes, having agreed to live with me, and take care of me in my old age, I desire at my death, that he shall have, and be entitled to hold my land, stock and all the property, I may own both real and personal for which he shall pay the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars either before or after my death which amount of three hundred and fifty dollars is to be divided as follows my son George Howell having received the most is entitled to nothing my sons Riley Howell James Howell, John Howell, Alexander Howell and my daughter Polly Legrand shall each receive fifty eight dollars & 33 cts, the amt of fifty eight dollars and thirty three cents which my son Ezra Howell should have, I desire shall be held by Charles Lipes to pay William F Howell this Sep 30. 1871
