In the name of God amen I Mary or Polly Gibbs became wife of Thomas Gannon having children at this present time being supposed mine lawful heirs I am now then only my children having married twice. Since and no offspring from these last husbands I am now ^{that} all that I am or may be entitled to ^{be} considering every other property that is or may be due to me when collected that same after all my just debts is paid that it may be divided as follows. Item my will is that the all lands in the State of Pennsylvania or other States that I may be entitled to or any parts thereof from wills deeds or conveyances at this time not known to me the said lands or their value as valued for to be equally divided amongst my children hereafter mentioned with this exception first that my son Edward Gannon for his services and money expended on me my will is that he shall and must have receive the amount of three parts for the other legacies one out of my estate real and personal money or I agree to wit all sums paid by my son Edward Gannon for expenses on my account to be taken out of my money or any personal property to pay for the same the residue of my estate real and personal after reserving two legacies for him for his services rendered to me I leave and bequeath as follows equal parts to all to wit Thomas Gannon Edward Gannon two parts Anthony Gannon Elizabeth Gannon Mary Gannon Samuel Gannon Nancy Gannon Margaret Gannon William Gannon. Being informed in body the of perfect mind and memory do make this my last Will Testament or conveyance revoking all other Wills bequests or pawns of Attorneys to this day before made. In witness hereof I hereby appoint my following sons executors and agents to settle my business (viz) Edm^d Gannon Samuel Gannon Witness my hand & seal this May 15th 1819
