Any personally or house furniture that I may have. I bequeath to my wife Mary for her use and benefit

I Will last that my burial expenses shall be equally shared and paid by Abel and Nathaniel

After Abel and Nathaniel have received their equal Shares one half acre each. I now devise that Richard shall receive an equal share with them in any balance of land including dower or any excess over two acres
