In the name of God amen I James Duncan senior of the County of Buchanan & State of Kentucky being weak in body but of sound mind & memory do make this my last will & testament I will & bequeath all of my estate both real & personal to be equally divided between my wife Heathy my youngest son Samuel & if my wife should marry all my real estate to be given to my said son Samuel & my wife Heathy is to give my 3d son good education out of her part of the estate and at her death all of my estate is to go to my said Samuel Duncan except one dollar to be equally divided between my sons James William & John & daughter Polly. In testimony whereof I set my hand and seal this 18th day of February 1817

In the name of God amen I Polly Montgomery of Buchanan County State of Kentucky knowing that it is now appointed that all mortals must die and being in a low state of health but of sound mind do make this my last will and testament in the following words to wit First recommending my body to the earth from whence it came & my soul to God who gave it Secondly I give & bequeath all my estate which consists of bonds and interest in this State & a portion in the State of Maryland to which I am legal heir to my beloved uncle Samuel Beason & in the third & last place I appoint my beloved uncle Samuel Beason executor to execute this my last will & testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this seventeenth day of January 1818
