Examined I Robert Hall of Buchanan County & State of Kentucky, I do hereby make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit, after all my just debt ~~has~~ paid in full I give and bequeath to my mother Marthy Hall all the land from the Elizabeth town road on the South Side of said road commencing at the upper corner of the farm with the fence so as to include the fence ~~thats~~ to Stephens Hall line thence with Stephens Hall line to Isaacks Whitworths line with the same to the Elizabeth road up said road to the beginning I also give to my mother Marthy Hall my present growing crop all my Hogs & sheep & cattle mares & young & my Gray Horse & all farming tools all my cash & cash notes & accounts after my debt is paid. I wish my mother Marthy Hall to pay out of these effects Daniel Macey fifty seven dollars for seven months work that said Macey has & will do hereafter also I give to my brother Stephen Hall all the balance of the land on the South Side of the Elizabeth road commencing at the upper end of the farm up said road to the Stephen Boards old track with the same to Edward Haynes line with the same to the corner thence with Stephens Hall line to the old ladies land set out in this Will all the remainder of my property to my sister Susan Hall including land & stock. July 12th 1853

That I Stephen Rawlings of the County of Buckenridge and State of Kentucky being of Sound disposing mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and testament I give and bequeath to Caroline Hanks wife of John Hanks my eldest daughter one dollar and to Wm Rawlings my son one dollar and to Vanez Kellin wife of Jefferson Kellin my daughter one dollar and to ^{Robert} Kellin my son one dollar and to Sarah wife of Charles Macey my daughter one dollar and to Wm Rawlings my son one dollar and to Stephen Rawlings Jr. my son one dollar and also to Charles Kellin son of Betsey Kellin one dollar I give and bequeath to Allen & Lev R Rawlings my two youngest sons all my Estate real and personal (except the sum of Eight dollars above named) and also my wifes wearing apparel Bedding and Kitchen furniture) after paying my just debts the balance is to be equally divided between the two I give and devise to my beloved wife Wmings all her wearing apparel Bed and Bedding and Kitchen furniture which at her decease shall be divided between my two youngest sons Allen & Lev R Rawlings to be equally divided between the two 4th I ordain and appoint my friend Geo B Holly as executor of this my last will and Testament I testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal and publish and declare this to be my last will and testament in the presence of the witnesses named below this the 15th day of January 1862 Stephen Rawlings
