 In consequence of the infamous & wicked conduct between Lucina Francis my first wife Mary & Ann I do hereby disinherit them.  
 My daughter Jane & Sister Abigail do receive the last part of my estate.  
 My son William Sebastian has likewise received his full part of my estate. Therefore they cannot expect any provision further by my will.  
 2<sup>nd</sup> For the better care & of final disposal of my son Charles Sebastian during several years residence with him I do give and bequeath unto my said son all the residue of my estate both real & personal. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 25<sup>th</sup> day of July 1834 and I do hereby appoint my son Charles Sebastian the sole executor of this my last will & testament

Then and after the death of my wife my will & desire is that my estate be equally divided between Rebecca Esq and all the rest of my body begetten & unborn. Therefore I make this my last will & testament. At which I set my hand even after my seal this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1834
