County Vp. do hereby make my last will and Testament
1st I desire that out of my perishable property all my just debts
and funeral expenses be paid - 2^d I. my beloved wife Mary Spencer
do bequeath my home farm. Household and Kitchen furniture. my sword
mar and choice which I own during her natural life and what
Money I may have on hand at my death to have and to use
during her natural life
3^d I. my Daughter Ellen S. Giggins I give one dollar. 4th I. my
other five Children Samuel Spencer, Sarah Ann P. Rose. Robert Spencer
James Spencer, John W. Spencer, and Jas. R. Compton my Grandson - I
make an equal division of my personal estate except that I only
give J. R. Compton one half as much as my five above named children
provided he should live to be twenty one year old. if not his part shall
occur to the five above named children, 5th After the death of my
wife Mary Spencer I further desire that the Real & personal property
left to my wife in this Will be equally divided between my five
children and Grandson above named, that Samuel Spencer, Sarah
Ann P. Rose. Robert Spencer James Spencer, John W. Spencer and
my Grandson J. R. Compton have an equal division of the same
except that J. R. Compton only have one half equal share with my
five above named children provided he should live to be twenty
one year of age and if not his share shall occur to my five above
named children, And lastly I appoint my two sons James Spencer
and J. W. Spencer my Executors of this my last will and Testament -
