

I Samuel Bevin of Breckenridge County and State of Kentucky, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do make publish & declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoke all former last wills and testaments by me heretofore made.

my will is first that my funeral charges and just debts shall be paid by my executors hereinafter named. The residue of my estate and property which shall not be required for the payment of my just debts, funeral expenses and the expenses attending the execution of this my last will, and the administration of my estate, I give devise and dispose of as follows to-wit: Whereas I have six heirs to say, Austin Bevin, Felix Bevin, Elizabeth Mc. Carter, Henry, of the son of Henry Bevin and my Daughter Martha, R. also Malissa, and Robert children of Francis A. Wayne my daughter Mary, and Elizabeth P. and Samuel children of Samuel Bevin Deceased. I will that my Estate should be shared as follows. Austin Bevin to have one share, deducted six hundred dollars, which I have paid him. Felix Bevin to have one share deducting six hundred dollars which I have paid Elizabeth Mc. Carter to have one share deducting six hundred and fifteen Dollars, which I have paid him. Henry of the son of Henry Bevin and Martha my daughter, to have Three hundred and fifty dollars out of my estate when he arrives to the age of Twenty one which is all my Estate which is willed to him, the children of Francis A. Wayne and my daughter Mary to have one share deducting six hundred dollars and the children of Samuel Bevin Deceased to have one share, deducting six hundred dollars I have paid them. I further will that Austin Bevin shall controul as trustee the portion which I will to Henry, & his of Henry Bevin until said heir shall arrive to the edge of twenty one years old, in case any of the minor heirs should die before the age of age, the portion allotted to them shall be divided between the other heirs. I also hereby appoint Austin Bevin & Felix Bevin to be the sole executors of this my last will and testament.

Known All Men by these presents that I Robert Chambers of the County of Breckinridge and State of Kentucky do Make and Constitute this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others 1st After the payment of all of my just debts and funeral expenses, it is my Will and desire that my beloved wife Ruth shall have all of my property both real and personal during her Natural life except if I should fail to give to my Grand Sons Jasper and Columbus Marlow a house each during my life then it is my Will and desire that my executor shall out of my personal property give to them at their coming at the age of twenty years a good house apiece or one hundred dollars in Money as they may elect

2^d After the death of my wife I Give & bequeath to my youngest Son Henry Chambers all of my real estate also old Slave Man Lewis and one hundred dollars in Money to be Made out of my personal estate provided however that if Slavery is ever abolished in Kentucky or by the Laws of the State a Slave Can be emancipated and Allowed to remain in the State then it is my Will & desire that the aforesaid Lewis shall be liberated & forever set free from Slavery & that the above Sum of one hundred dollars bequeathed to my Son Henry be paid to the said Lewis for his Maintenance

3^d I Give & bequeath to my two Sons Robert B & Henry Chambers the residue of my estate including my Negro Woman Nancy & her bay foal to be equally divided as between them in any way that they may see proper

I hereby appoint & Constitute my two Sons Robert B & Henry Chambers my executors to this my last will and testament Was signing them to be Secretary to certify as such
