

*Examined* I Thomas Lacy of the County of Breckinridge State of Kentucky do make this my last will and testament hereby ~~revoking~~ any and all former wills I may have made.

I give and devise to my sister Commarion Lacy all of my real estate in the county and State aforesaid during her natural life and all the stock household goods furniture provision and other personal property which may be thereon at the time of my deceased during her natural life as aforesaid; she however being directed to sell of the perishable property as may be sufficient to pay my just debts. At the death of my said sister the real estate aforesaid I give and bequeath to my three nieces Margret A Sheeran, Mary Sheeran, Norah A Sheeran equal shares; but if either of my said nieces should die before my said sister leaving no children living at the deceased of my sister then the said share of such property so devised to such deceased niece is hereby devised to the survivors of the three nieces; Should they remain after the death of my said sister any of the personal property upon the said farm; then I will and devise the same to my three nieces in the same manner. If my said sister should not survive me then I give and devise all the said property to my said nieces and their heirs forever charging them with the payment of my just debts: I do hereby constitute and appoint Daniel Sheeran executor of this my last will and testament. In witness I have hereunto set my hand this 29th day of January 1881.
