& ¹⁶⁶¹ ~~1661~~ he kept the said Wesley I request him to treat
him kindly in the way I have always treated him

5th I request my Nephew Joseph Westall to pay to my
Nephew
6th I bequeath to my beloved Nephew James L. Westall
of Texas five thousand dollars either in money
or good notes & I request my Nephew Joseph Westall
to present my Kinsman Jefferson Linings a tract of
land near Washington containing two hundred acres
purchased of A. H. Anderson I request him to make
Jeffersons & immediate deed I also request Joseph
Westall to present Wesley to J. Linings & also request
him to present him five hundred dollars either in cash
or good notes for I am under obligations to J. Linings
& would like to have him remunerated for his kindness
to me I appoint Joseph Westall & Jefferson Linings
my executors of this my last will & testimony they have
