testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this twenty eighth day
of December eighteen hundred and fourteen

At a County Court begun and held for the County of Buchanan
at the Court house in Hardinsburg on Monday the 20th day of February 1815
The annexed writing, purporting to be the last will and testament of William
Pyle deceased was duly proved by the oath of James Duncan Junior sworn
a notary there to have been signed sealed and acknowledged by the said
William Pyle now dead as and for his last will and testament and that
the said William Pyle was of sound mind and disposing memory and
that he the said James Duncan Junior subscribed his name as notary
therein in his presence and thereupon the same was laid on for further
proof And at a County Court ^{begun and} held for the County of Buchanan
at the Court house in Hardinsburg on Monday the 18th day of May 1815 the said writing was fully
proved by the oath of Charles Bond another notary there and ordered
to be recorded

In the name of God amen I William Munday ~~deceased~~ of Buchanan
County Kentucky being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory
helped be Almighty God for the same do make and publish this my
last will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say)
First, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Munday her heirs and assigns
one negro girl named Maria and all her future increase I do also
give and bequeath unto my daughter Rachel Munday her heirs and
assigns one negro girl named Mary and all her future increase I do
also give and bequeath unto my daughter Betty Munday her heirs
one negro girl named Maria Junet and all her future increase
I do also give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Munday and
my daughter Rachel Munday and my daughter Betty Munday
their heirs and assigns two negro boys Nellis and Geo also the one third
part of the one thousand acres of land on which I now live the above men-
tioned negro boys Nellis and Geo and land is to be equally divided among
them I do also give and bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Munday
his heirs and assigns one negro boy named Peter also one wagon
and a full set of harness I hereby give and bequeath unto my son
Nathaniel Munday and my daughter Ann Munday and my
daughter Rachel Munday and my daughter Betty Munday
their heirs and assigns all my horses cattle dogs and flocks of my
kind also my farming utensils and household furniture to be

divided amongst them I do also give and bequeath unto my sons Nathaniel
Munday and my daughter Ann Munday and my daughter Rachel Munday
and my daughter Betsey Munday their heirs and assigns the property and
every other thing that I have above milled to them that much I give and
bequeath to them exclusive of all the rest of my estate I do also give and
bequeath unto them all the remainder of my negroes for the term of
seven years for their own proper use and benefit during that time
provided they continue with my son Nathaniel Munday if they do not
I positively declare they shall not receive anything and if at the same
time these negroes shall remain in my son Nathaniel Munday's possession
for his own proper use and benefit during the term of 7 years if they
do continue with him they shall receive $\frac{1}{3}$ of the clear profit that
is by these negroes made my son Nathaniel Munday and my daughter
Ann Munday and my daughter Rachel Munday and my daughter Betsey Munday
shall now be charged one penny for the
service of these negroes and again they shall now be liable for any
accident or accidents happening to any thing which they may have in
their care or possession at any time after the expiration of 7 years it is
my wish for all my children to come forward and share an equal
part of these negroes last mentioned in my will I do also give and
bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Munday and my daughter Ann Munday
and my daughter Rachel Munday and my daughter Betsey Munday
an equal part with all the rest of my children of these negroes which
I gave to my son Nathaniel Munday and my three daughters above men-
tioned for the term of seven years as though I had now gave them
any thing I hereby give and bequeath unto my son James Munday and
my son Robert Munday and my son William Munday and my son
George Munday and my son Nathaniel Munday also my daughter Ann
Munday and my daughter Rachel Munday and my daughter Betsey
Munday an equal part of these negroes last mentioned in my will
I hereby appoint my son James Munday and my son Nathaniel
Munday executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking
all former will by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal the sixteenth day of April in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen
