

I, Allen M. Kincheloe, of Hardinsburg, County of Breckinridge, and State of Kentucky, being of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and testament, HEREBY REVOKING ALL WILLS HERETOFORE MADE BY ME.

FIRST: I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved wife, Elizabeth C. Kincheloe, during her natural life my homestead where I now reside, on Louisville Street and what was formerly the Peaman property, after her death I Give and Bequeath the same to my children equally share and share alike.

SECOND: I Give and Bequeath to my said wife all the household and kitchen furniture now in my said home, to be hers during her natural life and at her death to go to my said children share and share alike.

THIRD: My life insurance policy in the Connecticut Mutual Life Insurance Company, I Give and devise to my children by my first wife, share and share alike.

FOURTH: My Life Insurance policy in the New York Life, I Give and devise to my present wife and my children by her, share and share alike.

FIFTH: All my other property of every description both real personal and mixed I wish to be divided into two equal parts, one part I Give and Bequeath to my said wife, with full power to sell and convey same, and to use and enjoy the proceeds of same, during her natural life, at the death of my said wife should there be anything left, I Give and Bequeath the remainder to my children, share and share alike.

SIXTH: All the rest and residue of my estate, I Give and devise to my children, equally, share and share alike. It is my desire that all my children be made equal in the distribution of my estate, including the amounts they receive from the life insurance I have made advancements from time to time to all my children, all of which advancements whether now or hereafter made by me I desire that said advancements be taken unto consideration in the settlement and distribution of my estate, and it is my desire that all my children be made equal, that is to say that each child is to be charged with the sum total I have advanced it following is the names of my children and the amount advanced each set opposite their names:-
