

WILL

I, Annie Ryan, of Cloverport, Kentucky, being of sound and disposing mind, and memory, and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs while I have strength and capacity, so to do, do make, publish, and I declare this my last will and testament, that is to say:

FIRST, I order and direct, that my executors, hereinafter named pay all just debts and funeral expenses as soon after my decease as conveniently may be.

SECOND, After, the payment of such funeral expenses and debts, I give, devise, and bequeath unto the Board of Stewards and Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, of Cloverport, Kentucky, for the use and benefit of said Church, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars.

THIRD, After the payment of the foregoing bequest, I order and direct my executors, hereinafter named, to set aside the sum of five hundred as they may see fit, the income from said five hundred dollars to be used for the upkeep of my graves and the graves of my family.

FOURTH, I order and direct my executors, hereinafter named, to purchase and erect for my grave a suitable monument.

FIFTH, I direct that the remainder of my estate, real, personal or mixed be given, share and share alike to my grandchildren David Owen Hall and Lucille Cairns.

SIXTH, I hereby appoint Paul Lewis and William R. Popham, executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
