

WILL OF BARNEY SQUIRES,

July 1st, 1927,

I, Barney Squires being of sound mind and disposing memory publish and declare this to be my, do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking any and all other wills heretofore made me,

I. It is my will that all of my debts Just debts and funeral expenses be first paid

II. It is my will that all the rest and remainder of my property of whatever kind or character and ^{including all insurance,} wherever situated be and the same is hereby bequeathed and devised absolutely to my five children and to my Grandchildren Robert and Margaret Hendrick that is to say that my five children Andrew D. Gideon T. Milton M. Barnes P. and Kathleen Shrewberry shall each take a one sixth interest and the said Robert Hendrick and Margaret Hendrick shall each take a one twelfth interest,

III. In the event of my death before either Robert Hendrick or Margaret Hendrick shall arrive at the age of twenty one years then it is my will that the said share or shares shall be retained in the hands of the Executor of my estate until either or both of them shall have arrived at the age of twenty one years,

IV. In the event of the death of any of my children before my decease the share of such child shall descend to his or her children equally but if such child so dying shall not leave any children or children then the share or shares willed herein to such persons shall be equally divided among my surviving children and my two said Grandchildren except that each of my two said Grand children shall only take one twelfth part thereof,

V. In the event that both of my two said Grand children should die before my decease, it is my will my said children shall each take a one fifth interest in my estate but if only one of my said Grandchildren should not be alive at my death the surviving Grand child shall take a one sixth interest in my estate,

VI. I hereby nominate and appoint my son Gideon T. Squires as the executor of this will and as I have every confidence in him I request the Court to permit him to qualify as such without executing any bond except a sufficient bond to secure said Grandchildren Robert and Margaret Hendrick,

This entire will is written wholly in my own handwriting,
