

The last will and testament of Bluford Lewis.

I, Bluford Lewis of Irvington County of Breckenridge and State of Kentucky, being of full age and sound mind and memory do make publish and declare this my last will and testament hereby revoking all wills heretofore made by me.

Item One. I direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of the money I have on hand at the time of my demise, as soon as practicable thereafter.

Item Two. It is my will that my brothers Ben Fisher and Harrison Fisher be paid one dollar each out my estate and no more, I give this to them as token of my love and affection.

Item Three. I give and bequeath to Manala Fisher all of the residue of my property both real and personal.

Item Four. I make nominate and appoint Davis Ashcraft of Irvington to be the executor of this will and testament and I request that no bond be required of him as such and that no inventory or appraisement of my estate be made in so far as the same may be lawfully omitted.
