

March 20, 1918 .

I, Eliza J. Hendrick , declare this instrument to be my last Will .

1. Out of my estate all my just debts shall be paid .

2. When item 1st is complied with then out of my estate I Will and bequeath a sufficient sum to finish paying all claims & indebtedness against my late husband , Wm Hendricks estate & to settle his estate . In this way the lands belonging to my Children left by their father , will be free of all indebtedness & such benefit equally all of my said Children

3d . All my house hold & Kitchen furniture , bedding and Wearing apparel shall be divided by my Children among themselves , making each share as nearly equally as possible .

4th In view of the fact that my daughter Isabelle DeHaven is not as Strong as my other Children in health and that she is not as fortunately situated as are the other children , I Will to her the sum of \$ 500.00 & in the remainder of my estate she is to share equally With remainder of my Children :

5th . I nominate the Bank of Hardinsburg & Trust Co. Executor of my Will .

I have signed my name to this Will , Which I acknowledged & Which Was read to me before I signed it , the contents of Which I understand & such are Will . I sign my name to this Will in the presence of Claude Mercer & Dr A.M. Kincheloe & each signed his name hereto in my presence & in the presence of each other .
