4th; To Fanny Bruner of Custer Ky and Anny Dent of Rosetta Ky, two feather beds and bed clothing for same this to be equally divided between them Fanny Bruner & Anny Dent.

5th; To Emma Minter one quilt mostly green in color.

6; I want P.C. Dent my executor to place a tomb stone at my Mother and fathers graves also to erect one at my own, if there is a sufficient amount left from my estate after paying all my indebtedness to erect a stone at the grave of my brother Strother Kasey.

7th; And I do give devise and bequeath all the rest and and residue of my estate both real and personal to C.W.Kasey Anny L.Dent, Fanny Bruner, D.T.Kasey S.A.Kasey (H.S.Kasey dec and Strother Kasey dec) the heirs of my two deceased brothers to have there farthers equal share to be divided amongst themselves.
