Last Will and Testament of Ella B. Trent (Formerly Ella B. Kasey), of Big Spring
Breckinridge County Ky., Ella B. Trent of Big Spring Breckinridge County Kentucky,
do make publish and declare this my last will and testament (vs)

FIRST; I give devise and bequeath to Ella Kasey one and one half Dos Hens
and one rooster, also any four of my bed quilts she may want, this for staying
and taking care of me during my sickness, also 1 cloak & saddle.

Second; To Willie Perkins one black haffer calf for his kindness and atten-
tion shown me.

THIRD; P.C. Dent to take my bay mare and keep same a reasonable time, say
nine or 10 months and if she raises a colt in said time then said colt is to be
the property of Johnie Bruner the son of Fannie Bruner of Big Spring Ky, said
mare to be disposed of as hereafter directed with my personal property.

4th; To Fanny Bruner of Ouster Ky and Anny Dent of Rosetta Ky, two feather
beds and bed clothing for same this to be equally divided between them Fanny
Bruner & Anny Dent.

5th; To Rumar Minter one quilt mostly green in color.

6; I want P.C. Dent my executor to place a tomb stone at my Mother and
fathers graves also to erect one at my own, if there is a sufficient amount left
from my estate after paying all my indebtedness to erect a stone at the grave of
my brother Strother Kasey.

7th; And I do give devise and bequeath all the rest and and residue of my
estate both real and personal to C.W. Kasey Anny L. Dent, Fanny Bruner, D.T. Kasey
S.A. Kasey (H.S. Kasey dec and Strother Kasey dec) the heirs of my two deceased
brothers to have there farther equal share to be divided amongst themselves.

8th, If from any cause my marriage contract with Daniel Trent interferes
with my right or title in my home tract of land on which I now live near Big
Spring Ky, known as tract No. 2 containing 135 acres in the plat or settlement of
the estate of A.B. Kasey, deceased, or better known as the home of said A.B. Kasey
deceased, I hereby state under oath that it was never made known to me, and after
reading and rereading same was never able to understand said contract from the
fact it was and is so complicated, farther state that this land was my own in
fee simple before my marriage to said Daniel Trent and farther state that I never
received any consideration from him or any one else for said land, neither did I
borrow or procure any money from said Trent for any other purpose or deal, I
farther state that I only own one half interest in the above named tract of land
and having purchased it at the Court house door with my sister Mrs Anny L. Dent
and then the said Anny L. Dent transferred her half to my husband Daniel Trent I
farther state that I do not wish this instrument of writing to interfere with any
personal or real estate that I did not own before my marriage to said Trent.
This to my heirs as herein specified and assigns forever, I hereby appoint
P.C. Dent Executor of this my last will and testament and I desire that he (P.C.
Dent) shall not be required to give bond for the performance of the duties of
that office.
