

Will

I, Horace Hicks of Constantine, County of
Breckinridge, and state of Kentucky,
Being of full age, and sound mind and memory
do make, publish; and declare, this to be my
last Will and Testament.

First

That all my just debts and funeral expenses
be paid by Jesse Haskinson and wife Maggie
Haskinson. To whom I have deeded my Farm and
given by contract my Farming implements and
Household and Kitchen furniture, One mare and
Colt, One Cow, and 2 hogs.

For the care of myself and my wife Elizabeth
Hicks, during our life time.

Second

I now bequeath to the rest of my heirs to be
divided equally among them what money I
have. Also what notes I hold at the time of
my death and what personal property I may
have. I now have eight Children living, and
one son deceased. and I want the children
of the deceased son to take their fathers share
in my estate.

My Children living are as follows; Malcolm
Hicks, Mr. Henry Hicks, Naomi Dwall,
Mansom Hicks, Alpha Sharp, Nannie
Gregory, Georgia Haskinson, and my deceased
son was named Carl Hicks and he died
leaving five Children.

Third My youngest daughter Maggie
Haskinson will not share in this settle-
ment as she has accepted my personal
property as her share. Also I have provided for
my wife Elizabeth Hicks, her lifetime, in
other papers so she will not share in this
settlement either.

It is my desire that all advancements
made by me to my children be charged against
their interest in my estate and deducted from
their interest before they receive anything in the
settlement of my estate.

It is my desire that my son Carl Hicks

I make nominate and appoint Willbur Haskinson to be executor of this my last Will and Testament.
