

Will of John H. Heeler.

I, John H. Heeler, of Cloverport, County of Breckinridge, State of Kentucky, being of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills by me made.

Item 1. I hereby give, bequeath and devise to my sons, John Daniel Heeler and George W. Heeler, payable at my death the sum of fifty (\$50.00) dollars each.

Item 2. I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable after my decease.

Item 3. I hereby give, bequeath and devise to W. E. Popham, of Cloverport, Kentucky, all of my property, real and personal, of every kind and description, whatever situated, which I may own or have the right to dispose of, at the time of my decease, in trust, however, for the uses and purposes, and for the benefit of the persons hereinafter named, to-wit:

During the life of my wife, Melina Heeler, she shall, by the trustee and executor, be permitted the use and enjoyment of the entire income from my estate, which shall be collected and paid to her by the executor in quarterly installments, or oftener, if desired, and said trustee, my executor, and his successors, in the trust, shall hold, manage and control my property during the continuance of this trust, with power to hold, control, sell, invest and re-invest the same in such manner as he may think best, accounting for the income as aforesaid.

Item 4. At the death of my beloved wife, Melina Heeler, I give, devise and bequeath whatever there remains of my estate, of every kind and nature, to my children, George H. Heeler, Minna Ola Heeler, J. T. Heeler, William Ernest Heeler and my step-daughter, Mary M. Kelen, said estate to be divided between my four said children and my said step-

daughter, equally, share and share alike, I give to my two said sons said sums of fifty (\$50.00) dollars each and make my step-daughter equal with each of my other children, in the distribution of my estate, after taking a careful survey of the same and after due consideration of my obligations and relations to all concerned.

Item 5. I hereby nominate and appoint W.E. Popham, of Cloverport, Ky., as the executor of this my last will and testament.
