To my daughter Melissa Russel I give Ten dollars (\$10.00)
To My son James P. Speak I give Ten dollars (\$10.00)
To my son George Speak I give Ten dollars (\$10.00)
To my son Patric Lee Speak I give Ten dollars (\$10.00)

Likewise I make constitute and appoint my son Joseph H. Speak to be Executor of this my last will and testament without bond,
