

WILL OF MELINDA SANDERS,

Be it known that I Melinda Sanders of the City of Cleverport, County of Breckenridge and State of Kentucky, being of sound mind and in the possession of all my physical and mental faculties, do make and publish this as my last will and testament, that is to say that I Give, bequeath, devise and dispose of my estate and property as follows.

My debts and funeral expenses shall first be paid out of the real estate.

A sum of one hundred dollars or more shall be set aside for ~~me~~ a monument to my memory and that of my deceased, husband, the amount used to be governed by and at the discretion of my executor.

All of my house hold furniture, rugs, stoves, dishes and cooking utensils, curtains and clothing, I Give to my niece Annie E. Whitehead if living, if deceased to her then living children.

My dwelling house and lot with the other buildings thereon, shall be sold by my executor and he shall sign the deed for same and which shall be a good and sufficient title thereto, the proceeds of said sale shall be distributed as follows, one half to be used for the payment of debts & as above set out the other half shall be paid to the officers of the Ladies Aide Society of the Lucile Memorial Presbyterian Church of Cleverport, Ky, to be used by them for the benefit of said church.

Having full confidence in the honesty and ability of my nephew C. W. Hammie to carry out my wishes, it is my purpose that he qualify as executor and have full control of my said property and estate, that he shall not be hindered in ~~any~~ any way and that he shall qualify as said executor without bond and no settlement shall be required of him.
