E. Church South the balance to be divided between my children old and new Margaret F. Board, Margaret H. Board, Mary V. Board, Edith C. Harper my daughter Willie H. Board my son Shelton K. Board my son Gardner M. Board my son does not get any more until the rest gets the amount of this note he has enclosed he got the amount of this note years ago if there be any after the other get as much as this note then he can come in for his part in the balance.

I will Edith my daughter my trunk all my clothes of every kind, she is to have the silver two spoons also table spoons six of each that I got at Sister Lucy sale and my ring her father gave me and her father and mine picture that are framed hanging on the parlor room wall also my hair flower and frame and also my catch all, I have bedstead in my room, one in the parlor with feather bed mattress spring and boulders and big pillows on them, I want Willie my son to have one and Shelton my son to have the other one, Shelton is to have his choice and my chamber dresser I leave it to Margaret Board my grand daughter the rest of the household stuff I leave it to Shelton as he has not been housekeeping and has nothing of the sort that rocking chair Ruth covered I leave to her if she wants it.

The farm is to be sole and divided with the heirs one as much as the other Gardner part of the farm goes to his note if not paid before.

I Margaret F. Board wills Gardner M. Board gets no more from my estate until all the others gets as much as he has got in money my son Shelton is to settle up the estate without bond or charging and use offarm until settled.
