I, M^r. H. Quiggins of the county and state aforesaid and being in good health of body and mind and memory and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs while I have strength and capacity to do so. Do make publish and declare this my last will and testament.

First: I give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Annahell Quiggins one dwelling house situated on 4th St. in the Town of Hardinsburg and county of Buckinridge to have and to hold in fee simple or to sell and dispose of as she may desire, and all household furniture that I may be possessed of at the time of my death.

Second: I want all my just debts to be paid from my estate including funeral and burial expenses.

Third: The balance of my property both personal and real that I may be possessed of the time of my death to be divided in three equal parts, one-third to be given to my wife, Annahell Quiggins; one third to my daughter, Thera L. Davis and one-third to Floyd F. Quiggins, my son. In case either of my children should die without issue then their part shall go to the other child. In case both of my children die without issue then the entire estate shall go to my wife, Annahell Quiggins.

Fourth: It is my will and desire that my wife, Annahell Quiggins be appointed Executrix of my estate and that no Bond nor inventory be required of her. This will was written by me in my own hand-write and in due consideration of all parties concerned and that I have not been influenced in the making of this will by any one whatsoever.
