First: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable after the time of my decease.

Second: I give, bequeath and devise to Charles Briskey and Lina B. Briskey, his wife, my farm on which I now live lying and being in Buckinridge County, Kentucky on Claved Creek to be theirs absolutely and in fee simple. Also all farming tools and live stock and household and kitchen furniture. I do this because they are now taking care of me and promise

to take care of me during the remainder of my life, furnishing me board, medicine and medical attention.

Third: All the remainder of my estate of ever kind and description I devise to those persons who are my natural heirs and the same is to be distributed as the laws of Kentucky direct it to be distributed as if I left no Will.

Fourth: I make, nominate and appoint G. C. Hendrick the executor of this my last Will and Testament.
