I hereby nominate and appoint the Bank of Hardinsburg & Trust Company, of Hardinsburg, Kentucky to be executor of this my last will and testament, and I have this day delivered to it, for safe keeping the evidences of my property, for which a receipt it will be promptly delivered to me. My now executor shall have power to sell, reinvest and change the form of my estate as its wisdom dictates, from time to time, after my death before distribution.
