

On this day Feb 6th, 1929. I, Elisabeth Skillman of Cloverport, Ky. being of sound mind do hereby write in my own hand this my last will and testament, and declare all other wills made by me heretofore void.

Item 1. I desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid and a marker be placed at my grave.

Item 2. To my brother Charles B. Skillman I bequeath the sum of \$1000 (one thousand dollars) to return to him money advanced to me in gifts.

Item 3. I bequeath to my brother James R. Skillman \$3500 (thirty five hundred dollars) to return to him money advanced to me in gifts and to compensate him in part for the administration of my fathers estate and for the care of my interest in the farm.

Item 4. I desire that all that remains of all I possess after this 1, 2 & 3 are paid be divided equally, share and share alike among my three brothers Charles B. Skillman, Orville T. Skillman and James R. Skillman.

Item 5. I appoint my brother James R. Skillman administrator to serve with out bond.
