

WILL OF WICKLIFFE DEHAVEN.

I, Wickliffe DeHaven, of ClevReport, County of Breckinridge and State of Kentucky, being of full age and sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills before heretofore made,

ITEM 1. I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate, as soon as practicable after the time of my decease.

ITEM 11. All of the personal, real and personal, of every kind and description, which I now situate, except my homestead property, situated in ClevReport, which I may own or have the right to dispose of, at the time of my death, I give, bequeath and devise to my wife, Mattie Clyde DeHaven, absolutely and in fee simple.

ITEM 111. My homestead property, excepted in Item 11 of this, my last will, I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, for the remainder of her natural life, or until she shall remarry. In the event that my wife should remarry, or, if she does not remarry, in the event of her death, I give, bequeath and devise my homestead property to my daughter, Mary Katherine DeHaven, if she shall be living at that time, and, if she is not living, I give, devise and bequeath said property to her children then living, or, in event that my daughter is not living and has no children surviving her, at that time, it is my will that my homestead property shall descend to my lawful heirs.

ITEM IV. I make, nominate and appoint my wife, Mattie Clyde DeHaven, to be the executrix of this, my last will and testament, and I request that no bond be required of her as such, I further request that no inventory of my estate be made or taken, insofar as the same may be lawfully omitted.
