I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved brother R.S.Skillman and his wife as tenants in common during their joint lives with remainder in fee simple to the survivor my store and all the contents thereof situated in Stephensport Kentucky.

I, W.M.Skillman of the County of Breckinridge State of Kentucky, being in feeble health but of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last will and testament Viz;

FIRST. I hereby give and bequeath to my beloved brother Richard S.Skillman and Lucy Skillman, his wife, jointly or to either of them who shall survive the other my Store House and lot in the town of Stephensport Breckinridge County Ky, and all of the goods therein, also all of my interest in the business of W.M.Skillman & Co which is now carried on in the town of Stephensport Ky.

Second. I hereby constitute and appoint my brother Richard S.Skillman as my Executrix without bond or security, and in case of his death or disability his wife Lucy Skillman shall be Executrix without bond or security.

THIRD. I make this my last will and testament in confirmation and approval of a will made by me in Washington D.C. and dated January 1st, 1904. also Oct 19th, 1906. and a codicil dated Augt 24th, 1908, all of which writings are to accompany this will.

FOURTH. I make the bequests to my beloved brother Richard S.Skillman and wife because I have already given to my other relations a great deal more than I am now able to give to them, and because they have been and now are waiting upon me in my present helpless condition.

FIFTH- It is my will that if my beloved brother R.S.Skillman should die before I do, then his wife my sister in law Lucy Skillman shall succeed to and be seized of all the bequests, powers and conditions given and mentioned in this will.
