

WILL OF W. T. DOWELL

I, W. T. Dowell, of Garfield County of Breckinridge and State of Kentucky being of full age and of sound mind and memory, do make, publish, and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking all will by me heretofore made.

ITEM I. Should my wife, Alsey Dowell, survive me at the time of my decease and reposing full confidence in her and knowing that she will safely keep my property and that same can be entrusted to her I give, devise and bequeath all of my estate, real, personal and mixed, wheresoever situate, to my said wife, Alsey Dowell.

ITEM II. At the death of my said wife, Alsey Dowell and my decease, will and devise my all of my real estate wheresoever situate, to my son, Taylor Dowell to be his forever with the right to dispose of same at his desire.

ITEM III. At the death of my wife, Alsey Dowell and myself, I give, devise and bequeath all of my personal property to my legal heirs share and share alike.

ITEM IV I direct that my son, Taylor Dowell erect, a suitable monument at the graves of my wife, Alsey Dowell and myself out of the real estate devised to the said Taylor Dowell.

ITEM V I make, nominate and appoint my son D. D. Dowell to be the executor of this, my last will and testament, and ~~trust~~ I request that no ~~trust~~ be required of him as such.
