Alexander all my estate (after the payment of my just debts) both real and personal, upon the condition, that he pays to my daughter Sally Blackwell four hundred Dollars. It is also my desire if Sydney finds himself in a condition so to do, without embarrassment to himself, that he refund to my son Thomas Smith three hundred Dollars, it being a sum of

money said Thomas has for advanced to my son Frederick - but this I do not impose upon Sydney as a legal obligation. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 14th day of January 1834.
