have nothing out of my estate of the money which I have received to be paid with the rest of my brother Children it is understood that Lewis Ellyson should be maintaining said Christian in a decent manner the way to be heard out from said lands are after his death to be the property of said Lewis Ellyson Lewis Ellyson (Thompson) both of Lincoln County State of Kentucky and David Thron son of David Thron of Lincoln County Maryland my Executors to the my last Will and Testament and do empower my said Executors to execute proper Deeds of conveyance to the several persons for whom I have cleared out Lands on the tract and they who can produce a just claim to any Lands that may be surveyed and patented in my name and also those to whom I have given my Allegation for the conveyance of any particular tract of Land the usual terms of Land and other Legacies here before signified are given to the several Legates and their heirs forever To witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 8 day of October 1796
