Shire of Kentucky being weak in body but of sound mind and perfect
memory thanks be to god I do hereby make and declare this my last
Will & Testament hereby testifying all debts made herefore 1st I commend
my soul to god who gave it & my body to be entred in a Christian
like manner — Item 2nd my Will and desire is that as my Just
and Lawfull debt be paid by my executor — Item 3rd my Will and
desire is that my Wife Sarah & my Children live for the benefit
as long as they may in the plantation I now live in together with
all the Horse except few hereafter to be named all the Cattle Hogs &
flock of every kind farming utensils house hold and Kitchen furniture
of all kind for her use & the benefit of the four Children I have
born with her namely Miller, Rachel, Patsy & Henry but in case
she should marry again my Will is that she have the sum of One
dollar — Item 4th I Give & bequeath unto my son William Bayne the
sum of One hundred dollars together with what I have already given
him — Item 5th I Will and bequeath unto the Children of my daughter
Patsy daed the sum of One dollar a piece together with what I have
given unto Hinda Middleton her husband in her life time —
Item 6th I Give & bequeath unto my son John all my right & interest
to the land I gave him bought of Abraham Catamung two hundred
acres also the sum of four hundred dollars — Item 7th I Give &
bequeath unto my daughter Patsy, Walter, the sum of one hundred dollars —
Item 8th I Give & bequeath unto my son Jesse the sum of one dollar —
Item 9th I Give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth, Walter the sum
of one hundred & fifty dollars — Item 10th I Give & bequeath
unto my daughter Ann Walter, the sum of one hundred dollars —
Item 11th I Give & bequeath unto my son Miller and Brown Horse now called
and claimed by him — Item 12th I Give & bequeath unto my sons
Miller & Henry the plantation I now live in at the death of my
wife Sarah to be equally divided between them —
Item 13th I Give & bequeath unto my Children Miller, Rachel, Patsy
& Henry all the Money I have left when Called that is owing to
me after paying the several Legacies named above & after demand
if any & especially except the interest arising on the Money which
I Give my Wife to receive if she needs it & the sum to be equally
divided between them each to receive their portion when they become
of age
