On the motion of John Hume administrator of the estate of James William deid ordered that Archibald Main, Jacob Hume and Jonathan Greatheous being first sworn as appraisers in current among the personal estate and Hume if any opposite the said William deid reside and proposed and that they return an inventory thereof to the next Court

This day Archibald Main, Jonathan Greatheous and Jacob Hume took the Oath prescribed by law before me a Justice of the Peace for said County to appraise the estate of James William deid agreeable to the Written Order. Given under my hand this 17th day of May 1876
