In the name of God amen. I Parthony Overall of this State of
Kentucky and County of Bullitt knowing the uncertainty of life and
that all men must die do hereby make this my last will and testament
hereby disannulling all others. First I give and bequeath unto my
beloved brother Whittie Overall the whole of my worldly estate of every
description with this increase with the following conditions viz
At the death of my beloved brother Whittie Overall it is my wish
and do hereby so direct that my negro girl Rice now in his possession
shall descend or belong to Thomas Parthony Overall and from her sons
and her increase shall be considered as their joint and entire property
with the following restrictions - said slave not to be sold out of
the family either privately or by virtue of any process: And I do
hereby appoint my brother Whittie Overall my Executor to carry
this my last will into execution. Wherein in testimony I have here
unto set my hand and seal this 26 day of December 1830.
