In the name of god amen, I Jeremiah Croft of Bullette County and state of Kentucky being of sound mind and memory, do call to men's the men of my body, and knowing that it appropiate for all men come to die, do therefore make this my last will and testament that is to say - I give and bequeath to my friends Croft son & my sister Crofters - one Red and pumbers, one cow and calf, all my farming utensils, also one third part of all my crops now in the field or otherwise, to them and his heirs forever, but if to the said my friends Croft should die without marriage or issue lawfully begotten, then and in that case, the above mentioned property to be the right and estate of my children hereafter named - My father my wife and if my children hereafter named Miss Elizabeth Croft, shall enjoy and possess all the residue of my property both real, personal and mixed to her, her heirs and assigns forever, and lastly I constitute and appoint my above mentioned Miss Elizabeth Croft, sole executrix of this my last will and testament disannulling all other wills heretofore by me made - In testimony whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this nineteenth day of September one thousand eight hundred and fifteen.
