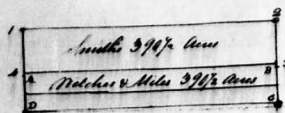

 line of said Rebye 713 1/2 Acre survey thence with the same S 45° W 100 poles
 to the beginning
 June the 9th 1826.



As the undersigned commissioners being called on by order of the Justice
 County Court we proceeded to divide the above mentioned land between William
 Melch and Samuel Melch son of James Melch Dec^d. we are of opinion that
 the division line at end of 50 poles splitting the survey through the middle
 the length way will give each an equal share in quality and quantity
 Given under our hands this 3rd day of July 1826. And we have allotted
 to William Melch that part of the land which lies on the Northwesterly side of
 the survey as reported by the surveyor above and to Samuel Melch the remainder
 half
