In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Allen of Bullitt County and State of Kentucky being of reflecting mind and sound memory, knowing that it is appointed to all men to die, do make order and appoint this to be my last will & testament, hereby annulling, and doing away all thing which heretofore by me made and devised - this in the manner and form as follows, to wit: First my will is, that my body be decently buried in the earth - And my soul to God that gave it - My will that my just debts be all paid - Then to my dear beloved wife, the plantation whereon we now live on, and all the negroes and stock of every kind to be at her disposal during her natural life - And at the death of my wife it is my will that the plantation and all the negroes and stock be equally divided between my two children, Harriet Vanmeter & Matthew Campbell and they have forever - And it is my will that if there is not wherewith enough to pay all my debts, the land must be sold and pay them - and the tools in my stock my two son in - Law Thomas Vanmeter and Mrs Compton can do as they think proper - And I do also appoint William Hill as an Executor of this my will As witness hereunto I set my hand and seal this 3 day of June 1822
