Giles Gano Receiving in the immortality of the soul & mor-
tality of the body that all must die, have reason to be
thankful that I have been through divine mercy had to re-
ceive the atonement of our blessed Saviour Jesus Christ - is
sufficient for every true believer who has been enabled by divine
grace, to trust in him for the salvation of the soul & eternal
life & happiness. Knowing the certainty of death of this body,
tho' in perfect health at present - conscious it is a duty
to make & acknowledge this my last will & Testament hereby
revoking & annulling all other wills by me made & declare this
as my only absolute & irrevocable will & that no informality
or irregularity should make it void - As it has pleased
God in his good providence to bless me with some earthly estate
& with an amiable wife & children I do hereby will & request
it as follows -

1st To my affectionate wife Mary Gano I give & bequeath my
house & mine acre & half of land in Lexington, entire, as
formerly belonged to Mr. Kernal, also all the household fur-
niture of every description & two horses & a carriage

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I have such as she may choose after my death belonging to the
estate. I do will & bequeath to her her three and a half acres in and
either her interest out of my land stock or keep in stock as she may
prefer or part with by sale of any other property, to my loving
youngest daughter Mary I give with the care & custody & patronage
of her mother, when the said child shall arrive to the age of eight
years three thousand dollars to be raised out of the sale of real prop-
erty & be deposited in bank for her or as her mother shall direct or
be assigned in real property by persons appointed by my executors &
heretofore, the above request which is due for her benefit -
I do not favor the assign. The whole of my estate in Cincinnati
in Lexington & land of every description to be sold on as reasonable
and first that all my just & equitable debts be paid out of the realty
& the balance of all my estate real & personal should be equally
divided between my three sons Daniel, Aaron & John & that
Daniel Gano only should pay out of his proportion to my
daughter Sarah four hundred dollars in property as she has been
given property more worth ten thousand dollars & I have had
to support her & three children a considerable time & I am
sorry to say has been a very unprofitable child, given myself
& family by his imprudent alliances in marriage much trouble
& say no more on that subject; except to declare it is my
will that himself or husband John Hughes shall receive no
interest or further participation of any of my estate real
or personal & the children of the aforesaid Sarah by a second
husband I leave a suit of mourning to, out
of my estate & such other provision as their grandmother
thinks proper out of her estate, I do hereby appoint & name
Gano my administrators, & my sons Daniel & Aaron &
John administrators do act jointly in all matters ap-
pertaining to this my last will & Testament, & they are
hereby fully empowered to sell divide & conform to every part
& article of this my last will & Testament wrote with my own
hand. I beg that it may be ratified by the court. Court
granting full letters testamentary thereof & I beg that no
informality may bar the due execution of every part thereof
as I am in a weak mind memory & possessing all the
mental faculties I ever did & in good health but expect
shortly to travel & this life being uncertain has caused
