 bandry Also eight cows three calves three two year old
 heifers two two year old steers and one Bull one
 horse and a yearling Colt one negro man named
 Clark and all my stock of hogs and all and every
 Part of said Property I the said Joseph Barnett
 do Will and bequeath to the said Mary Barnett
 my loving Wife to remain and be her own and
 as she the said Mary are now with Child of the said
 Child as live I Will and bequeath three hundred
 Dollars to, is to be Paid by the said Mary Barnett
 when it Comes Maturity as Part of the above
 mentioned Estate, Also one Rifle Gun one old
 Rifle Gun that are not before recited, I also do
 bequeath the said Mary Barnett with every Power
 in collecting my Debt and Paying legal dem-
 and against me, I hereby notify this to be my
 last Will and Testament In testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal
