 same time I shall leave the same
 against by the mighty power of God as
 as touching my worldly Estate, where
 - that hath pleased God to bless me in
 life, I give and bequeath of the same
 in the following manner and form -
 I wish I give and bequeath to William my
 - dear beloved Son, my Land and prop-
 - erty and property enough to claim it
 out of the office. Only my dear beloved
 wife is to live on this long as she has cause
 without any disturbance. Also I give to
 my dear beloved wife all the rest of my
 - property as long as she lives, and then it be
 - equally divided amongst the rest of my
