We the undersigned appointed by the Christian County Court as commissioners to assign to Thebe Youngs widow and Relicks of David Youngs Deceased her Dowry have proceeded and done the same by laying off and setting apart her Dowry in the real Estate of the said Youngs Deceased We assigned to the said Widow the third part of two Tracts of Land left set apart for her the third part of the Tracts of Land on which the said David Youngs died in the following manner To wit Twenty Acres of the improved Land belonging to said Tracts and the same bounded as follows.
