The day the undersigned signed our papers appointed by the Christiana Society, sent at their September meeting to settle with the Administrators of Joseph Fountain deceased, have discharged that duty, giving the receipts by the said Administrators to Two hundred & fifty two dollars & 6 cents therein - disbursements to \$222.96 cents leaving a balance of said Admrs of \$40.08, which deducted from an allowance of \$100 to Peter Fountain one of the Admrs for his services shown as balance in his favor of two dollars & 6 cents as well more fully appears by a reference to the within account, which added to the claim of Mc Fountain for Board, Doctor attendance for Polly & by Fountain Minor \$110.70, makes a total balance against the estate of \$126.77. There is also found in the hands of said Administrators arising from the intestate's personal property, and the hire of negroes, been number named & finally amounting to nine hundred thirty seven dollars & 89 cents exclusive of interest, the tract of land now arising by survey 275 acres, never having been particularly mentioned in management.
