H. Sigarden, James Ruffin, Jesse Payne and Wiley Campbell
or any three of them Commissioners to settle with the Administrators
of John Guinn Deceased the same Report of the Commissioners and

Wiley Campbell being three of the Commissioners appointed to settle
after having been duly sworn before David S. Patton a Justice of
the Peace for the County of Christian this day proceeded to adjust
and settle the same, Benjamin F. Wood one of the Administrators
of the said John Guinn deceased being present.
We find the amount of the Estate by the same Administrators of the said
John Guinn deceased which came to the hands of the Administrators
of the said Guinn according to a copy of the Sale Bill (which is
of Record) to us produced to be \$1841.48

We find the amount Due the Estate by the
Administrators for the Rent of the Farm for
the Year 1818 according to Vouchers here with
filed signed by P. F. Wood Adm. aforesaid to be \$367.50

And also the amount due the said Estate for the Hire
