Morgan Hopson Guardian for the Heirs & Representatives of Edward Boyd Decd. up to the 1st of January, 1819 made the following Report that it appears from the Amount paid out to the Legales and the Expenses necessarily attending the said Estate there is in the hands of said Guardian Two Thousand Three hundred & fifty Seven Dollars & fifty Eight Cents the greater part of which is Bonds & Notes due to said Estate there is also produced for the above Charges which is herewith enclosed for your examination all which we think is but reasonable and ought to be allowed as the greater part was actually paid out by the Guardian which we think was necessary to be done, as to the Guardians Charge for his personal trouble as Guardian we think his charges are nothing more than reasonable Given under our hands November 2^d 1819
