waive and defend the slaves for the above mentioned
periods the s^c Jas^o Carlan against us and all persons
other persons & persons who have or shall have
& seals this 18th day of Sept 1827

It is agreed that if the above slaves or either of them
should die within the above named periods the heirs
at the rate of \$100 per annum shall cease that being the
price he has agreed to pay for them
